A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SNOQUALMIE, WASHINGTON, APPROVING THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SNOQUALMIE AND KING COUNTY REGARDING THE ANNEXATION OF A PORTION OF THE SNOQUALMIE MILL PLANNING AREA AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN SAID INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, King County invited the City of Snoqualmie to work cooperatively with King County to pursue immediate annexation of a portion of the City's Mill Planning Area in the City of Snoqualmie's Urban Growth Area into the City of Snoqualmie, and

WHEREAS, on March 28, 2011, the City Council approved Resolution 992 authorizing the Mayor to negotiate an interlocal agreement with King County regarding the annexation of a portion of the Mill Planning Area, and

WHEREAS, an interlocal agreement in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A has been negotiated between the City of Snoqualmie and King County, and

WHEREAS, the City has published the proposed interlocal agreement once a week for two weeks on November 2, 2011, and November 9, 2011, in the Snoqualmie Valley Record, a newspaper of general circulation in the City and the territory to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing as required by law was held before the Snoqualmie City Council on November 14, 2011, and

WHEREAS, City Council finds that the interlocal agreement in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A should be approved, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Snoqualmie, Washington, that the Interlocal Agreement Between the City of Snoqualmie and King County Regarding the

Annexation of a Portion the Snoqualmie Mill Planning Area in the form attached hereto
